The Electricity Program prepares students for entry-level jobs in the architecture and construction industry. The program provides students with hands-on training associated with residential electricity. Students in this program earn their OSHA-10 and forklift operator certifications. Students in this program have the option for dual enrollment credit through Brightpoint (12 credits).

Program Outcomes

By the completion of this program, students will be expected to demonstrate an introductory level of competency in the following skills:
